'My Number' Social Security / Tax Number System 社会保障・税番号(マイナンバー)制度

- What is 'My Number'?**
A 12-digit number which will be issued to every individual with a Resident Register (住民票 / *Juminhyo*). Even foreign nationals, provided they have a Resident Register, will be allocated a 'My Number.'
- Purpose**
To increase efficiency and transparency of the social security and taxation systems, and bring about the realization of a more convenient, fair and equal society for all residents.
- Types of government operations to which the 'My Number' will apply**
The system will be introduced in three areas, namely social security, taxation, and disaster countermeasures.
- Schedule**
A notification card (通知カード / *tsūchi-kādo*) with your number will be sent to the address at which you are registered by registered mail between mid-October and late November, 2015. Use of the 'My Number' system will begin in January, 2016. Individual number cards (個人番号カード / *kojin-bango-kādo*) will be issued upon request from this time.
- Important**
Please keep the notification card in a safe place, and do not disclose your number to anyone except for government- and employment-related procedures.

November is "Know Your Garbage and Recyclables" Month! 11月は分別マナーアップキャンペーン月間です。

Are you separating your garbage and recyclables correctly? Let's have a quick refresher on how to separate recyclables from other waste. Plastic bags (e.g. for snacks) and packs (e.g. for convenience store *bentō* lunchboxes) are classified as plastic containers and packaging (プラスチック製容器包装). Paper boxes and bags are classified as paper containers and packaging (紙製容器包装). Are any of these plastic or paper items mixed in with your burnable waste? If disposed of as burnable waste, these items will be incinerated, not recycled. Recyclable plastic and paper containers and packaging, as well as plastic bottles, are marked with symbols (see right) which specify the material type. By checking these symbols, you will be able to correctly separate your recyclables. Garbage and recyclables should be placed into the designated garbage bags and put out for collection by 8:00 on the designated day (7:00 for Naka Ward). Nagoya Sightseeing Route Bus Me~guru

⑥ Sakae Area なごや観光ルートバス「メーグル」⑥ 栄エリア

Do you know about the Me~guru sightseeing bus? Whether you're a tourist or a longer-term resident looking to check out some of Nagoya's sights in a convenient way (and minimizing the risk of getting lost while navigating between attractions), the Me~guru is a great, economical way to do it.

When: The Me~guru operates Tuesday to Sunday. (No service on Mondays, or the following day if Monday is a national holiday.) On weekends and national holidays, buses depart every 20-30 minutes; on weekdays, buses depart every 30-60 minutes.

Where: Me~guru buses depart from **Nagoya Station, Bus Stop 8** and stop at the Toyota Commemorative Museum of Industry and Technology, Noritake Garden, Nagoya Castle, Tokugawaen (The Tokugawa Art Museum, Hosa Library), Cultural Path Futaba Museum, Nagoya City Archives South, Nagoya TV Tower, Hirokoji-Sakae, and Hirokoji-Fushimi, before heading back to Nagoya Castle, Noritake Garden, Toyota Commemorative Museum of Industry and Technology, then return to the terminus at Nagoya Station.

★ **The Me~guru One-Day Pass** (available on Me~guru buses as you board) – Adults 500 Yen, Children 250 Yen; allows unlimited travel on the Me~guru for one day, and discounted admission fees to certain attractions (See prices in () for attractions below).
★ **Single Ride** – Adults 210 Yen, Children 100 Yen
★ **Weekend Eco Pass** – Adults 600 Yen, Children 300 Yen; allows unlimited travel on the Me~guru AND City Buses and Subways for one day.
★ **Manaca** IC cards are also valid on the Me~guru.

● **Nagoya TV Tower**

Standing at a height of 180 meters, the Nagoya TV Tower is Japan's oldest radio and TV broadcasting tower and is registered as one of the country's tangible cultural properties. The Sky Balcony, 100 meters above ground level, offers stunning vistas of the mountains of Suzuka and Ise Bay. The tower adds to the romantic ambience of the skyline when it is lit up in the evening. It was acknowledged as one of the night view heritage sites of Japan in July, 2013.

When: Jan. – Mar. 10:00-21:00; Apr. – Dec. 10:00-22:00 (Open from 11:00 on Sat., Sun. and national holidays; Closed irregularly.
Admission: Observation Floor: Adults 700 (600) Yen; Seniors over 65, College and Senior HS students 600 (500) Yen; Junior HS and Elementary school students 300 (200) Yen.

● **Oasis 21**
A multi-tiered park equipped with a bus terminal. In the glass "Spaceship Aqua" you can walk on air 14 meters above the ground, or enjoy lively events held virtually every week at the "Galaxy Platform." There is also a wealth of restaurants and shops to explore, making this quite literal oasis within the city a perfect place to take a break.
When: Spaceship Aqua and retail stores 10:00-21:00; Restaurants and cafes 10:00-22:00; service shops 10:00-20:00. (Hours may vary) Closed 1 Jan., semi-annual legally designated inspection days (shops only).

● **Aichi Arts Center**
Located in Nagoya's downtown Sakae area, this large cultural complex brings together a variety of cultural facilities, including the Aichi Prefectural Museum of Art and the Aichi Prefectural Art Theater. The center has various functions and hosts art exhibitions, concerts, and many other events. There are even restaurants and art shops, so there's always something fun to do, whenever you drop by!
